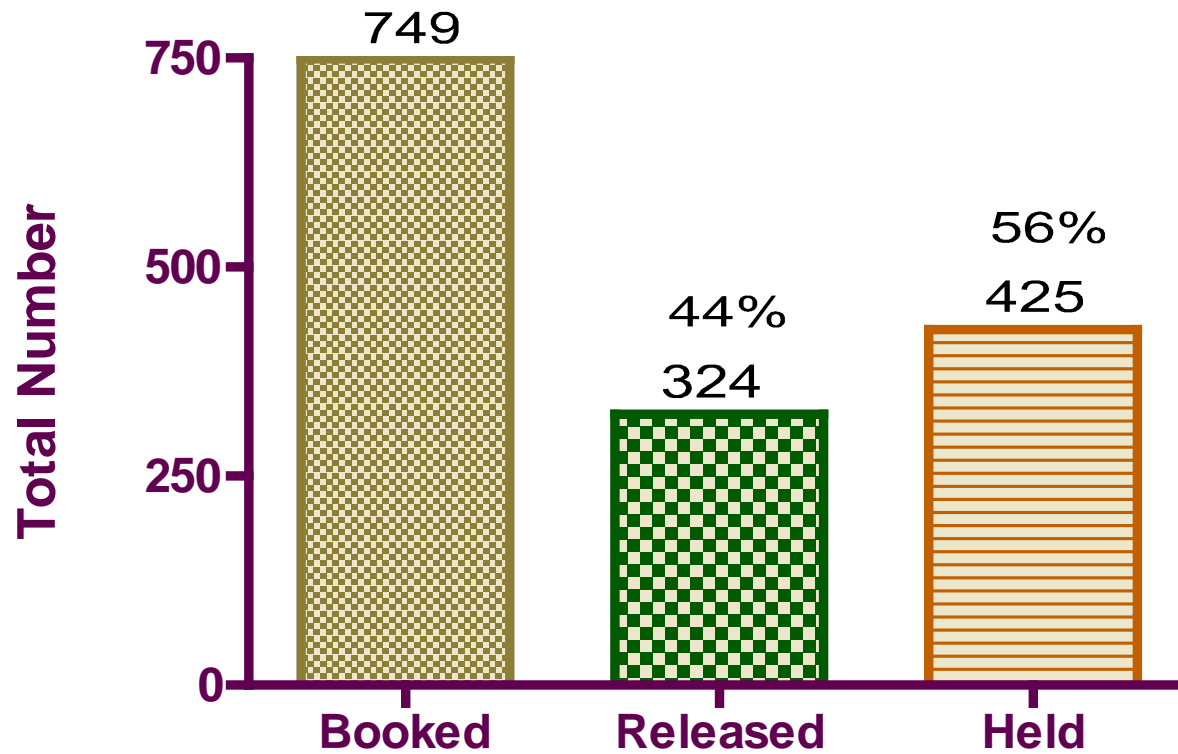

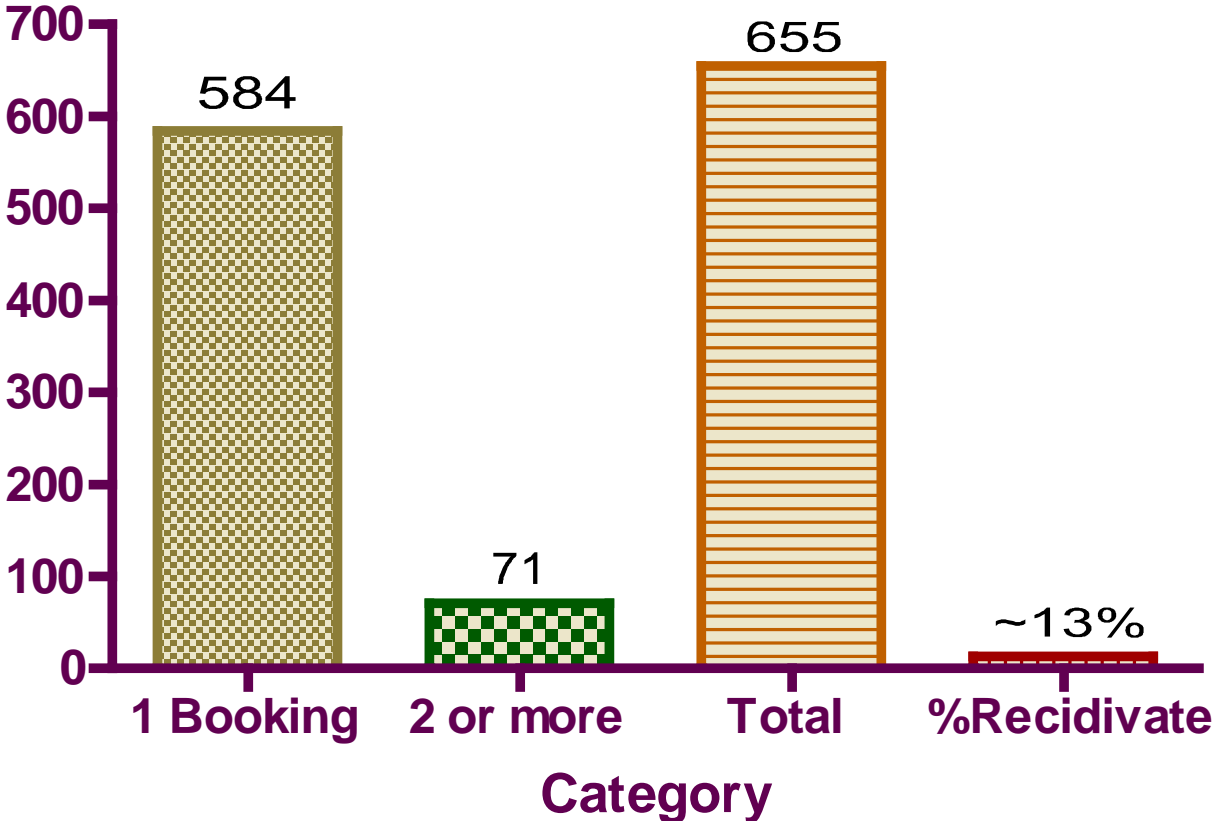

Overall Client Activity for First Quarter 06/07

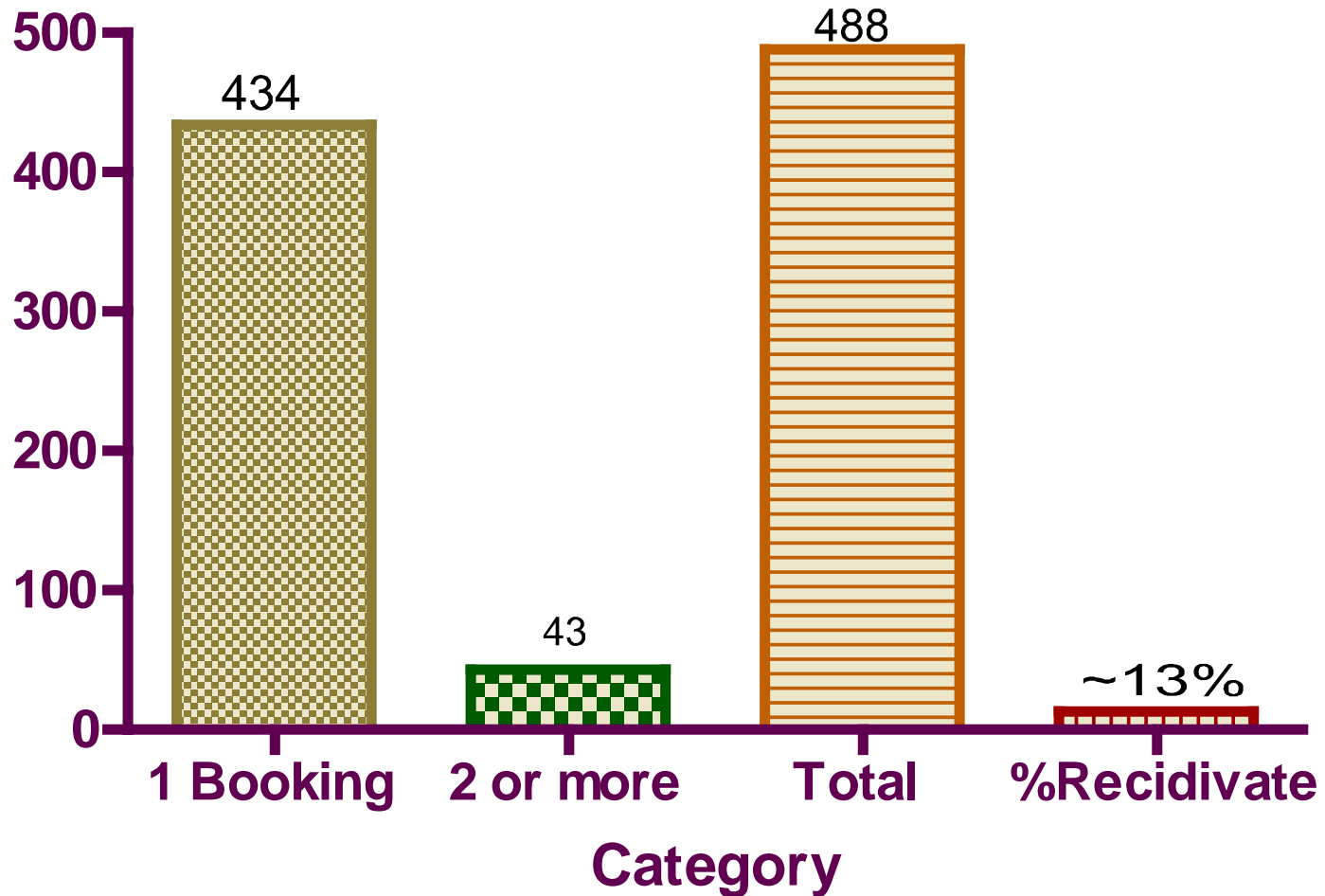

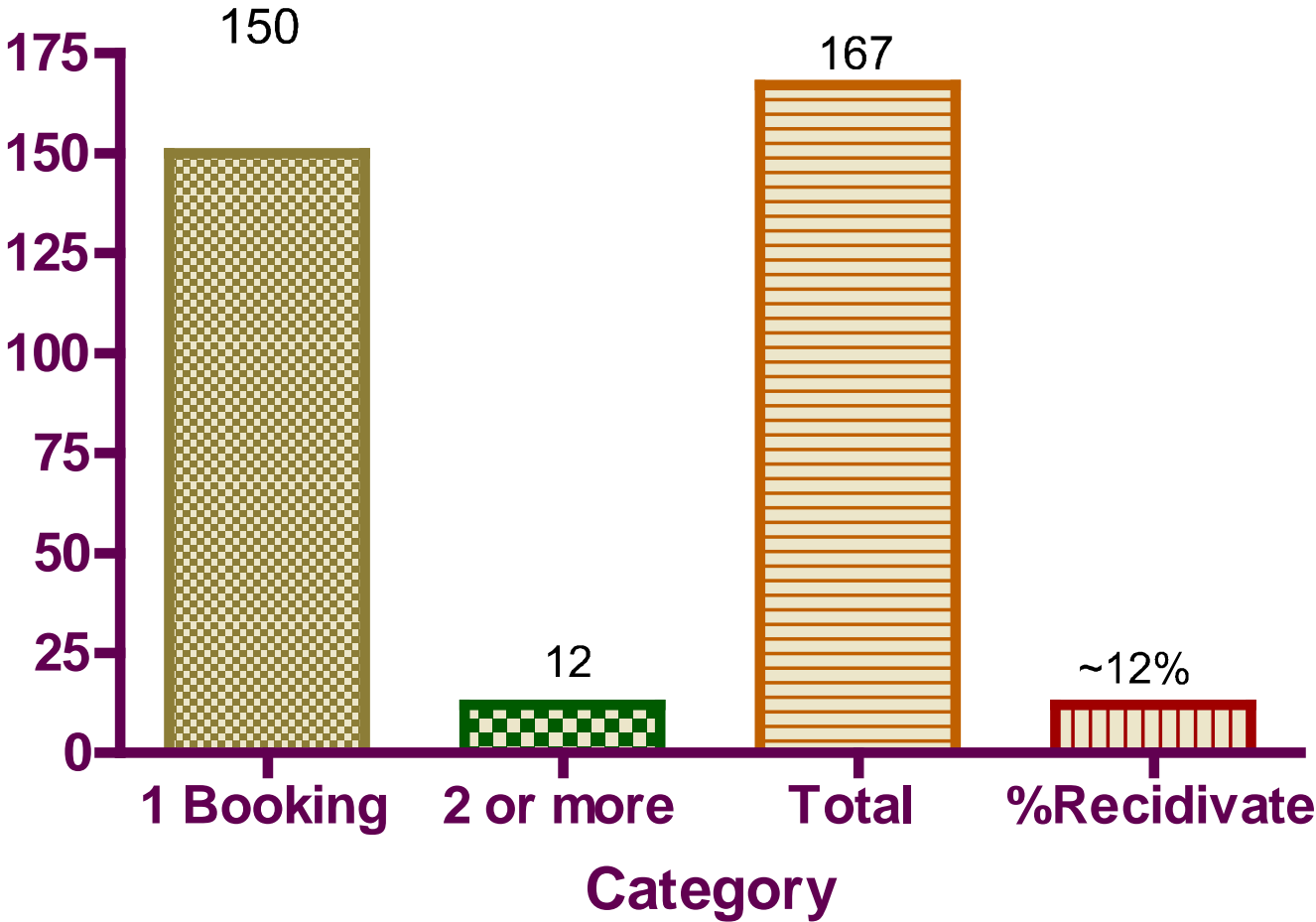
Recidivism for Those Booked in First Quarter of 06/07



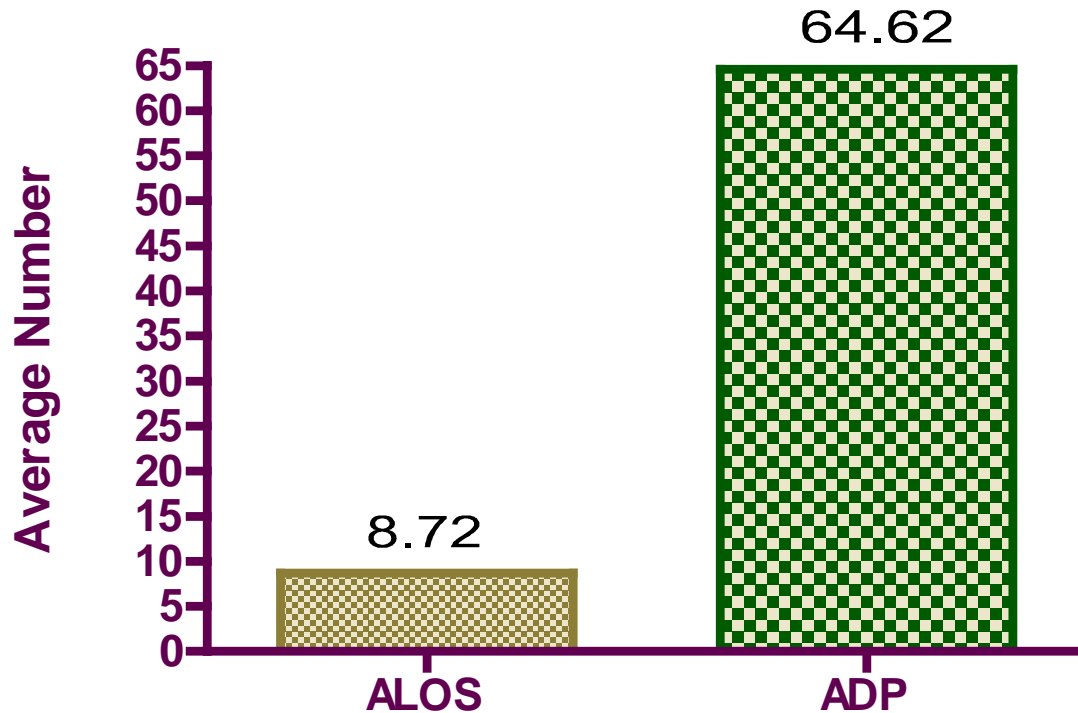
Male Recidivism Rate in First Quarter of 06/07



Female Recidivism Rate in First Quarter of 06/07



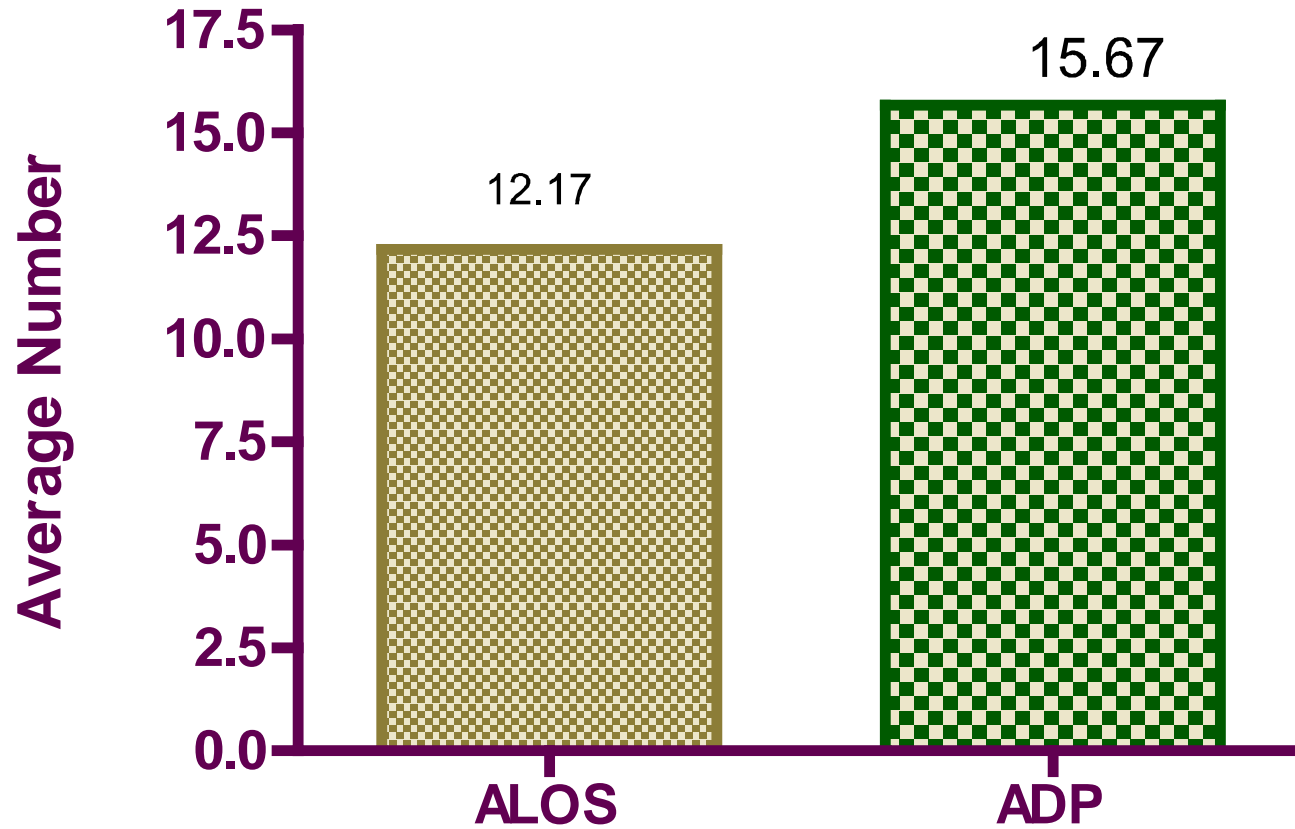

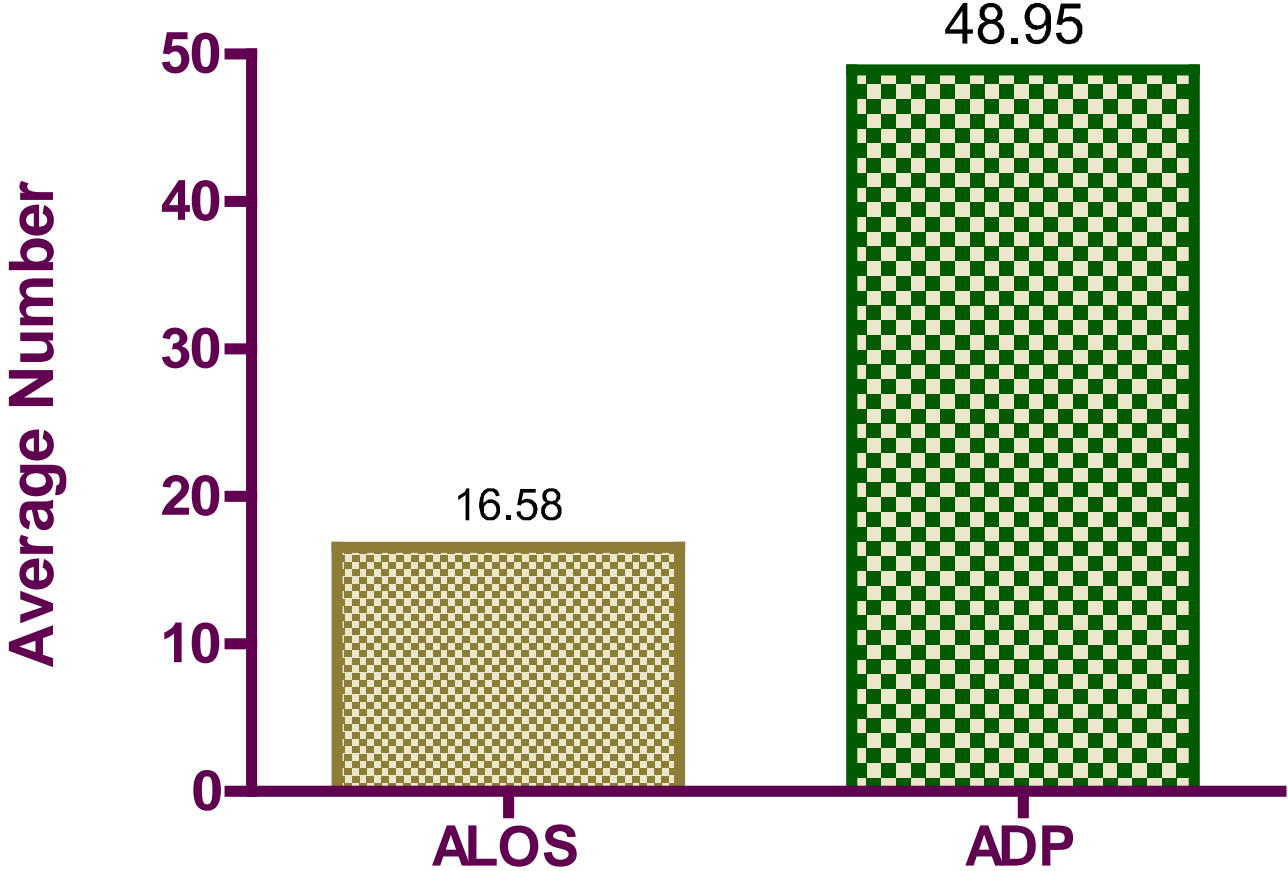
ALOS: Average Length of Stay; down 1.52 days from 4th quarter 05/06

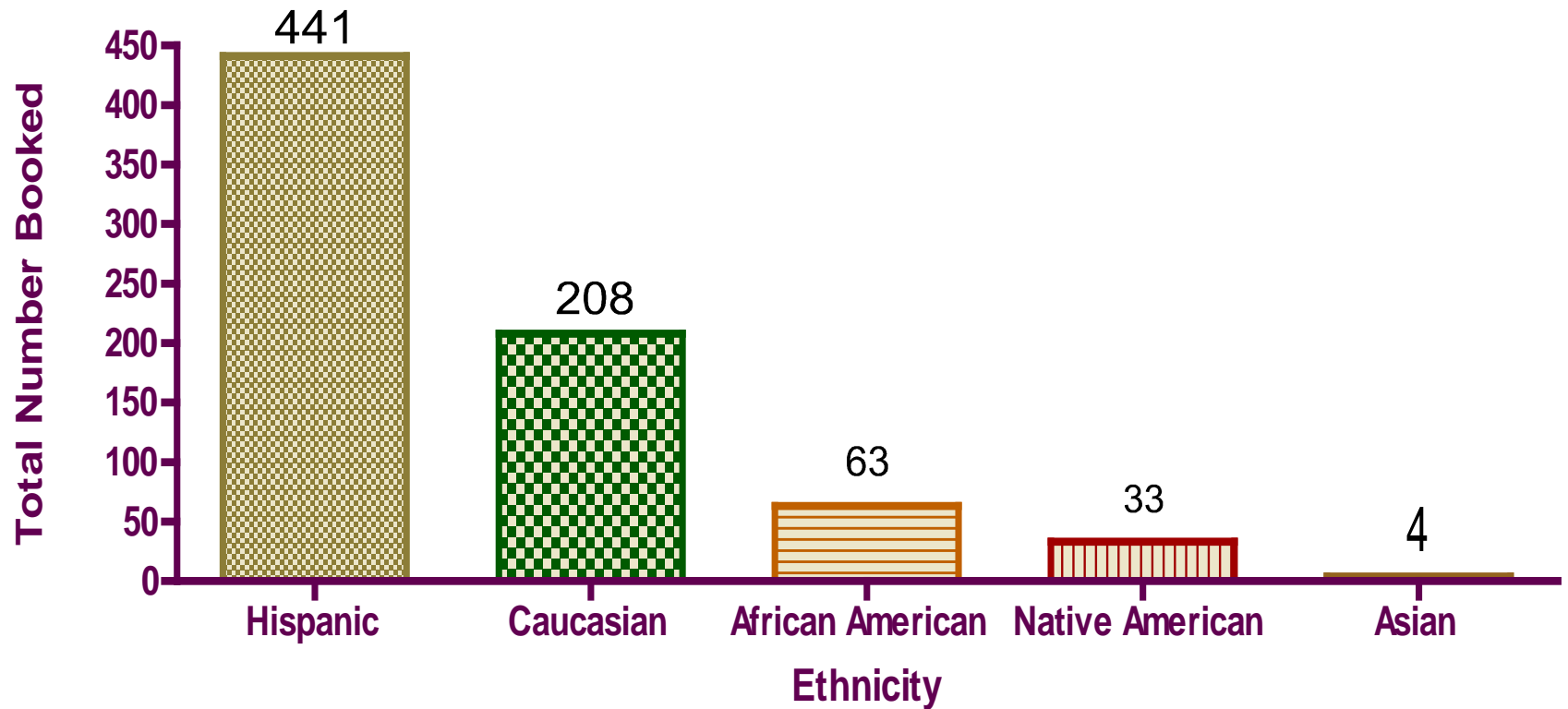


Male Release Report for First Quarter 06/07

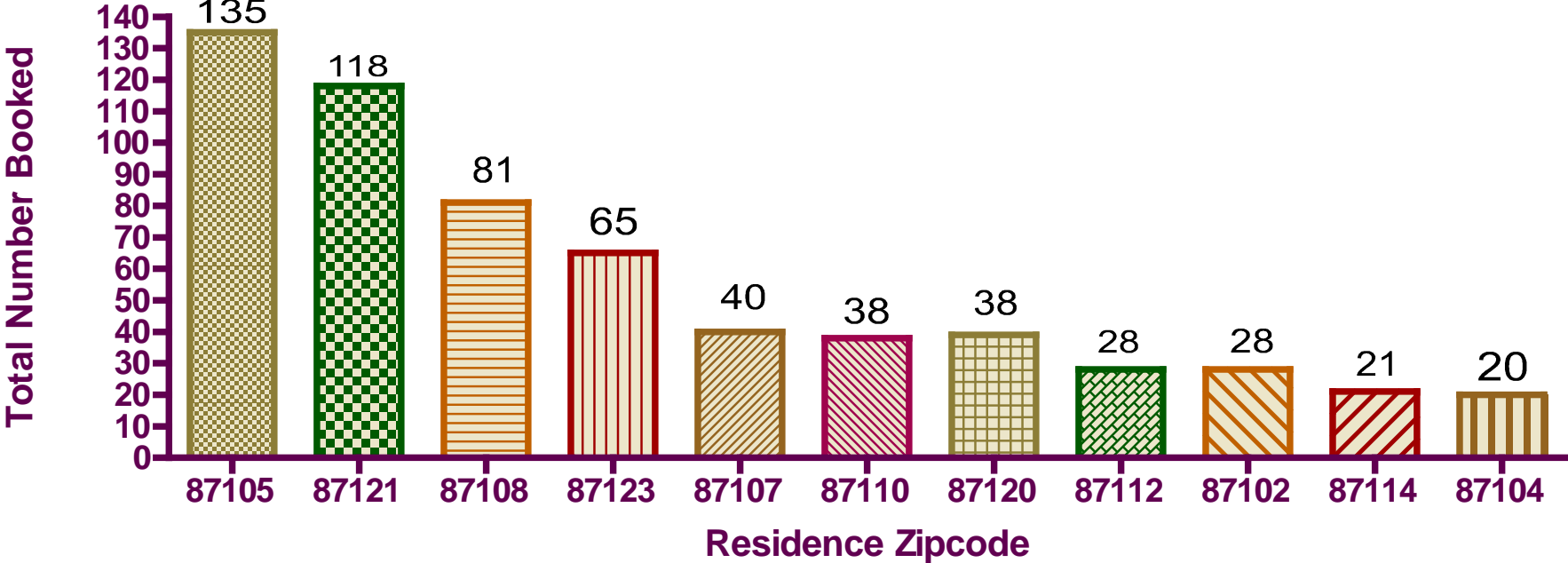


There was about a 40% difference between minority and non-minority bookings for the first quarter of 06/07. Up about 5% since last quarter in 05/06.

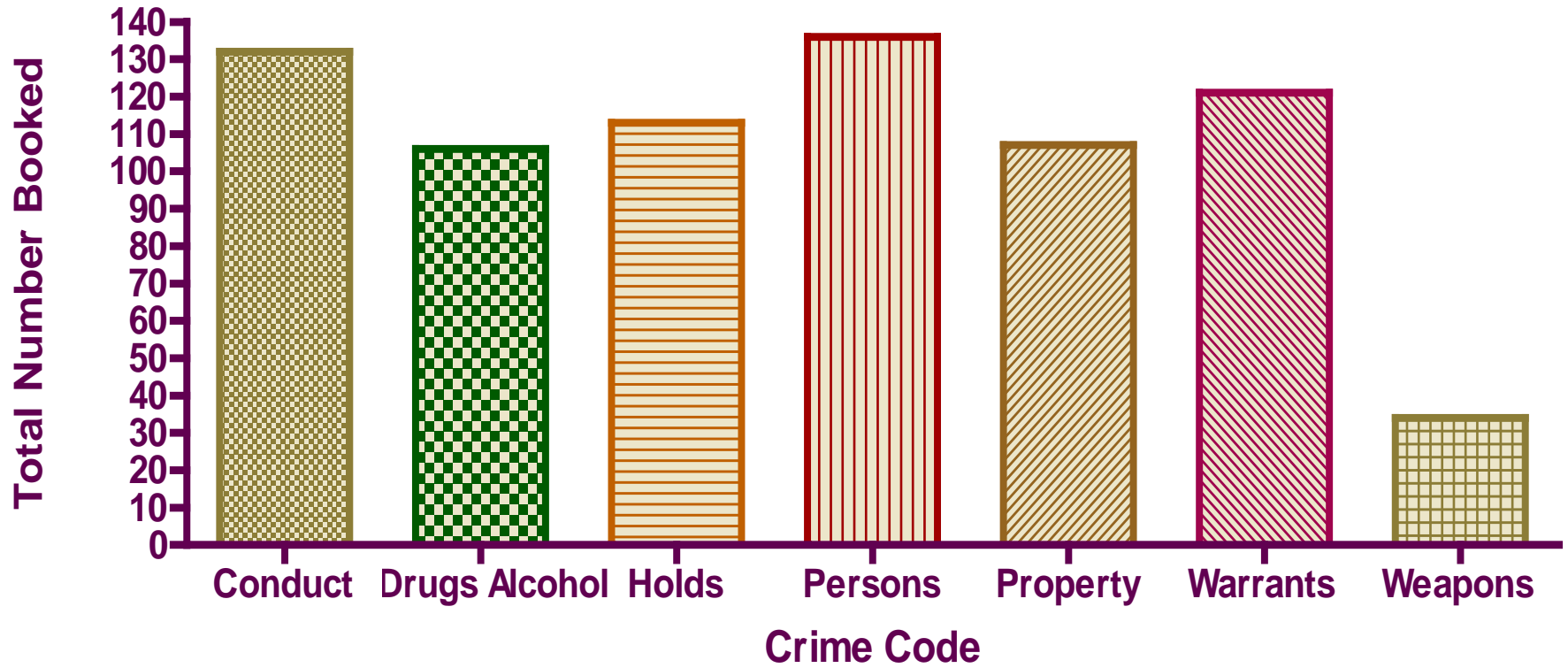
Ethnic Distribution for First Quarter 06/07



Residence Zipcode Distribution for First Quareter06/07

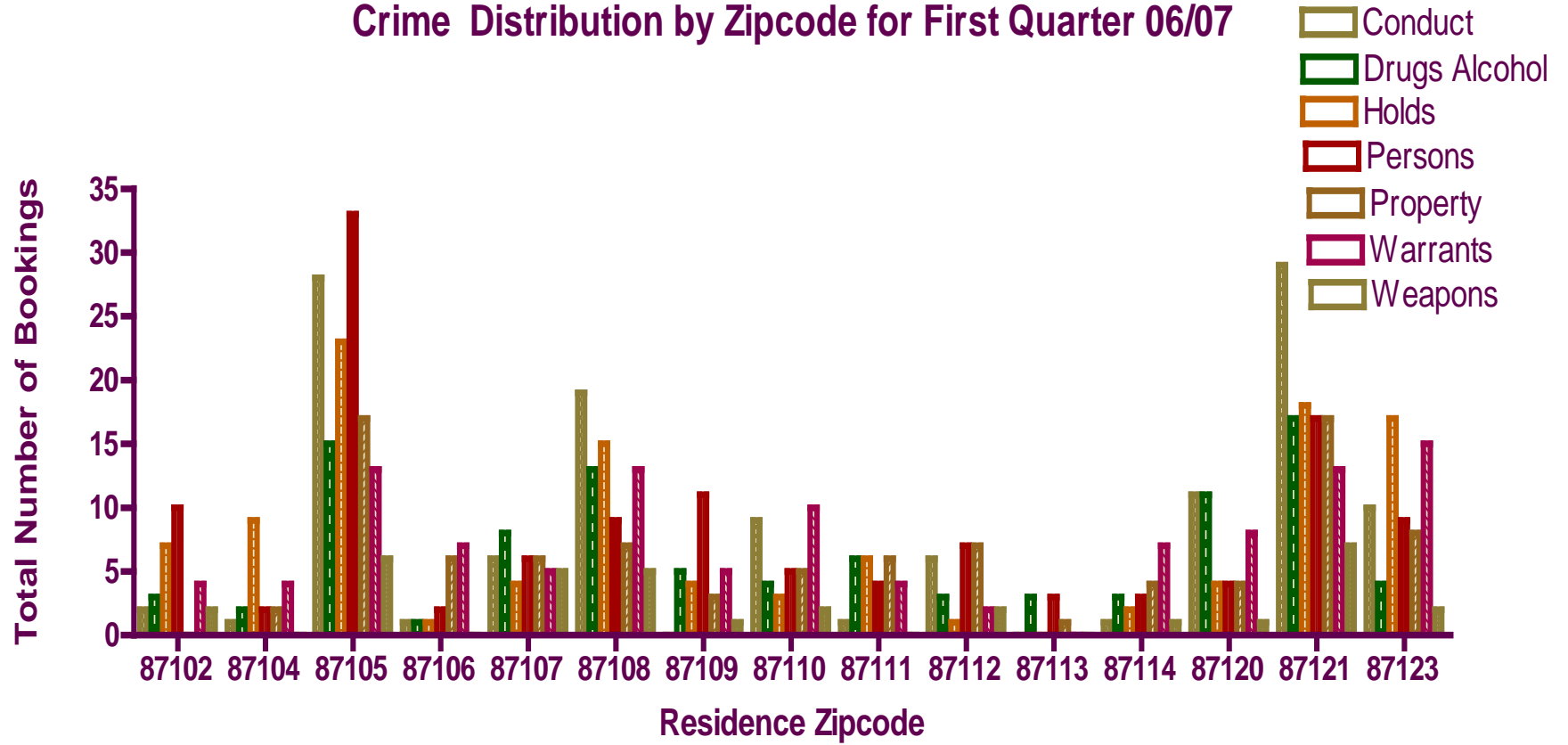


Crime Distribution for First Quarter 06/07

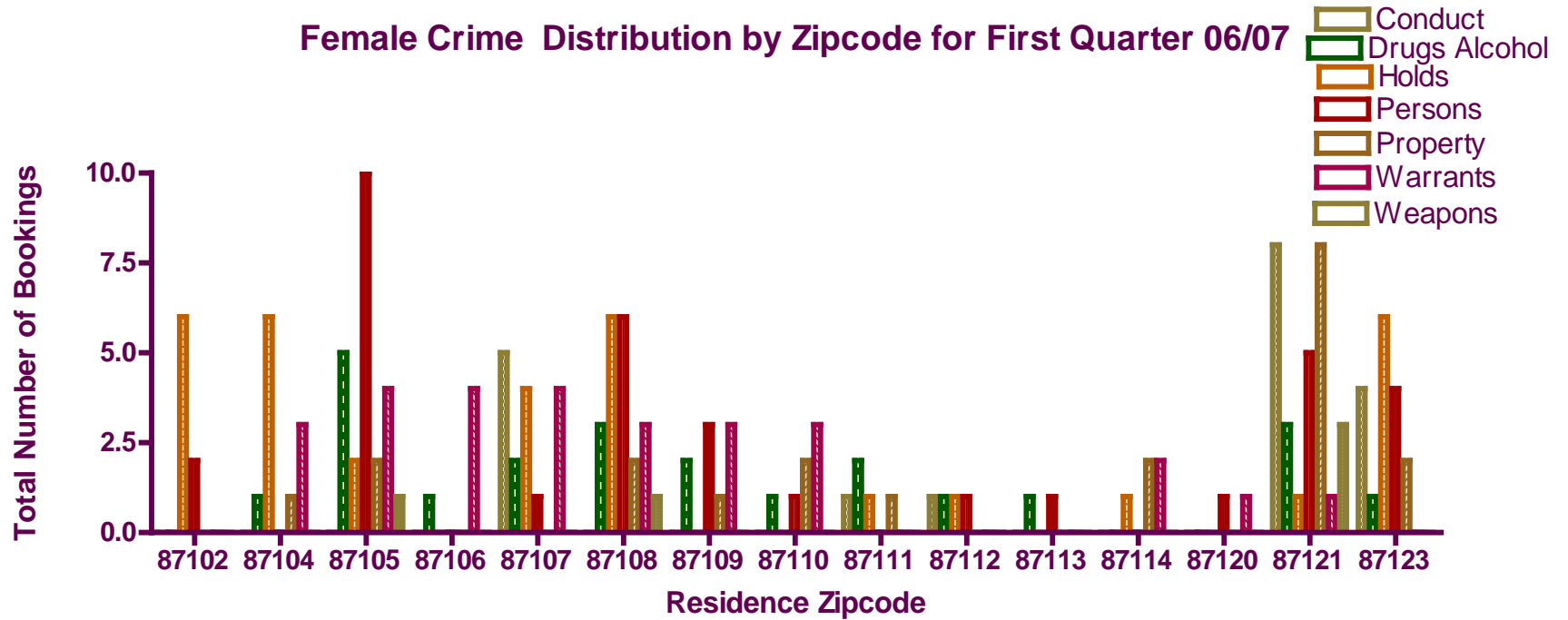




Crime Distribution by Zipcode for First Quarter 06/07

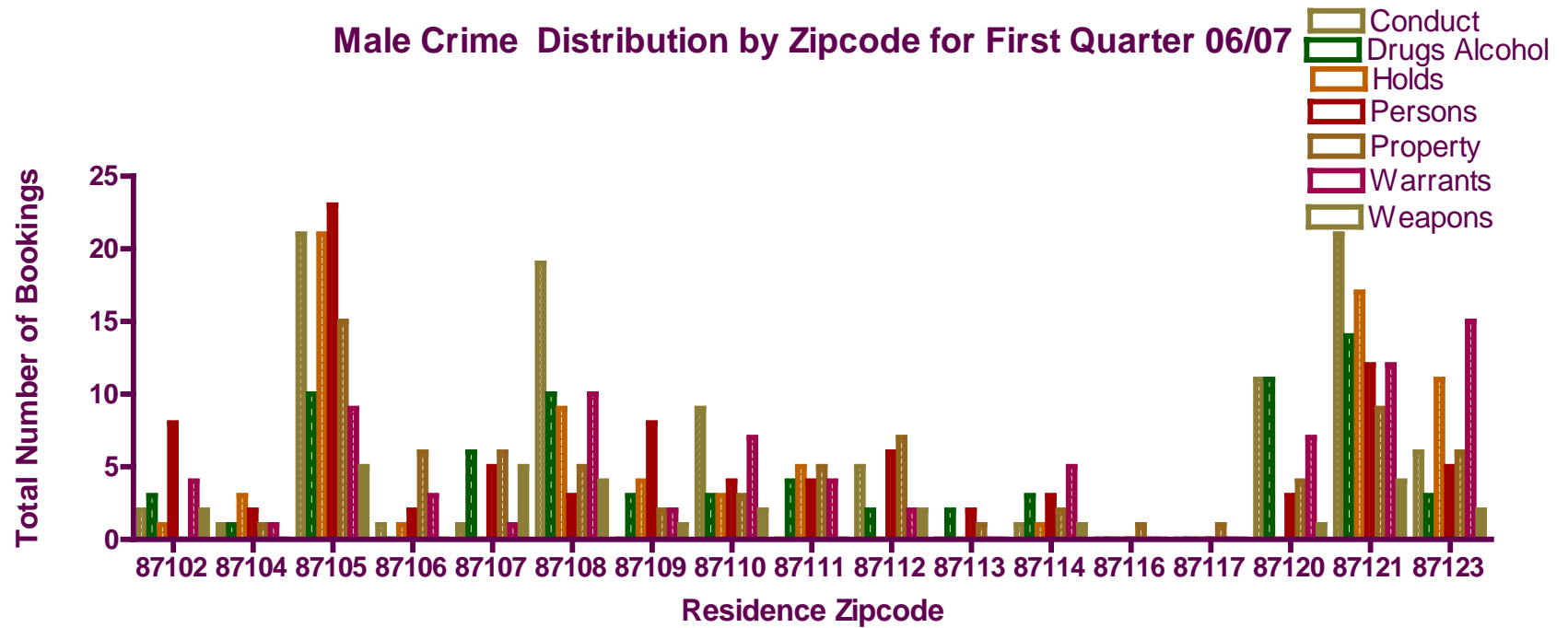


Female Crime Distribution by Zipcode for First Quarter 06/07

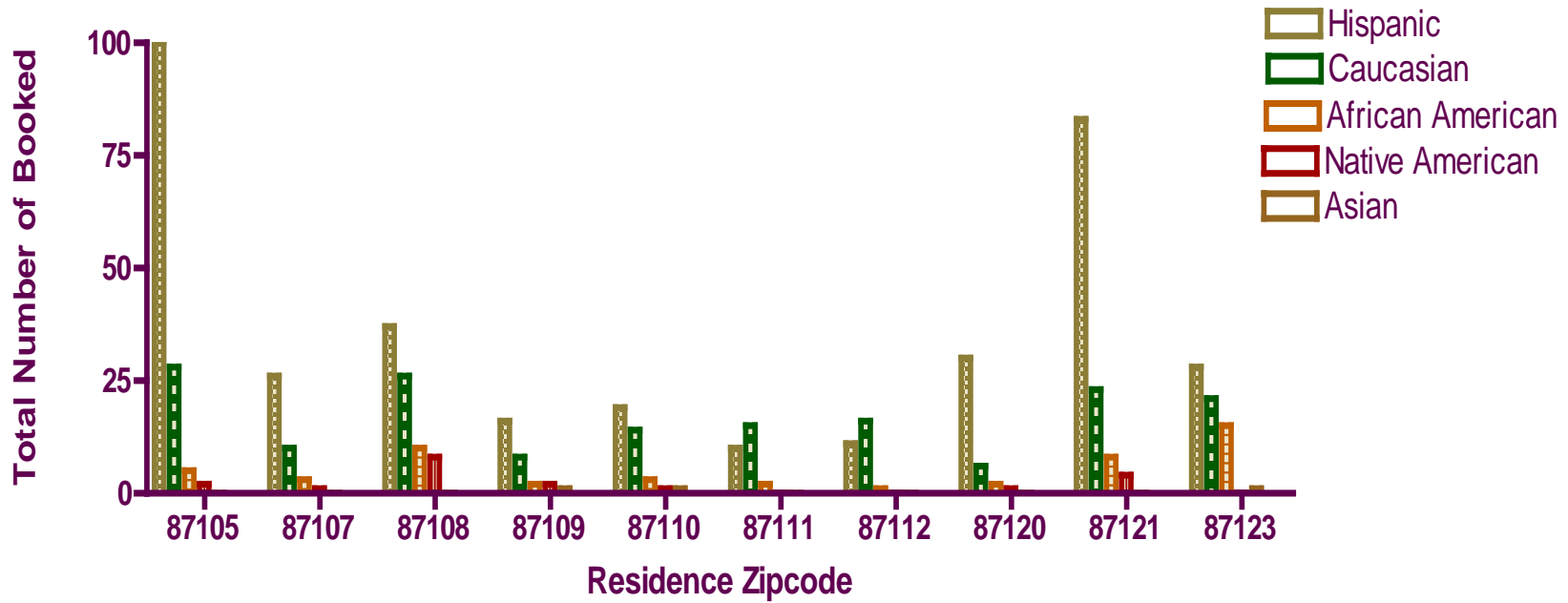




Male Crime Distribution by Zipcode for First Quarter 06/07

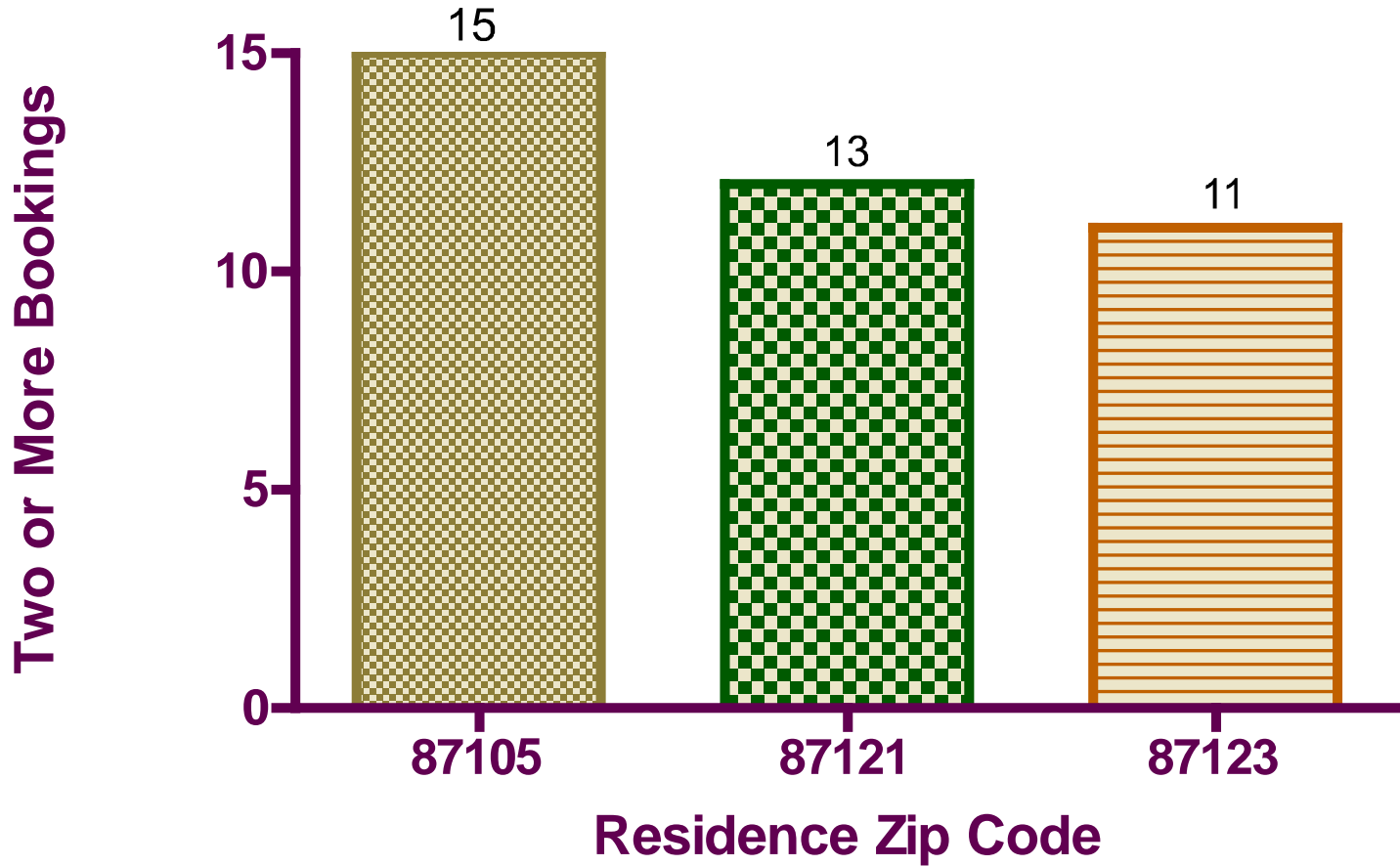


Ethnic Distribution by Zipcode for First Quarter 06/07

Residential Treatment Centers

- Disproportion of females awaiting residential treatment.
- A significant amount of both males and females who are held are held awaiting some kind of placement
- ALOS for females 48 days
- ALOS for Males about 25

- ADP for males on a given day last quarter was about 48. 15-20 were awaiting some type of placement for treatment.
- ADP for females on a given day last quarter was about 16. 10-12 were awaiting some type of placement for treatment.
- Of the males who were awaiting placement 10 eventually were released to mom compared to 2 females who were eventually released to mom.

- Both males and females are frequently booked on a probation violation warrant or FTA Warrant.
- Both males and females are coming from the top 2 zip codes with most referring bookings, 87105 and 87121.
- Both males and Females are majority minority.
- We need an alternative to RTC for those who qualify.
