Rite of Passage Mentoring and Tracking Program

“The mission of Rite of Passage is to provide an environment where all individuals feel safe, learning thrives, and accountability for behavior is a source of pride. We believe that changing behavior first requires an atmosphere of trust and safety and that all the client’s needs are met.”

The youths referred to ROP receive case management and tracking services seven days a week. Referrals for community based services and follow-up services are provided. DJJS officers receive weekly progress reports.

“Successful” = Completed Program

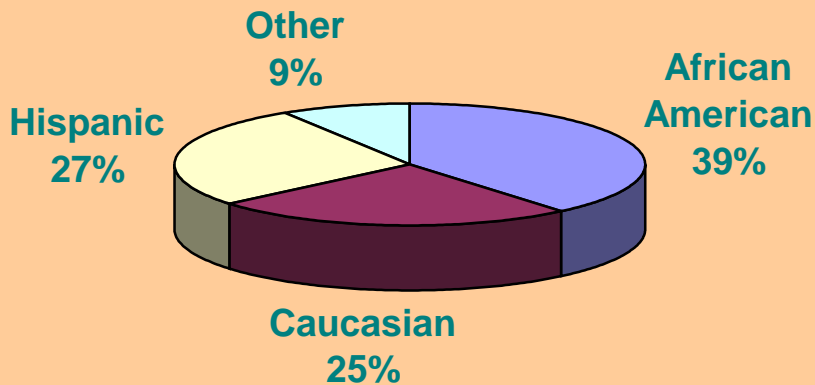
“Unsuccessful” = Received New Felony Charges While in Program

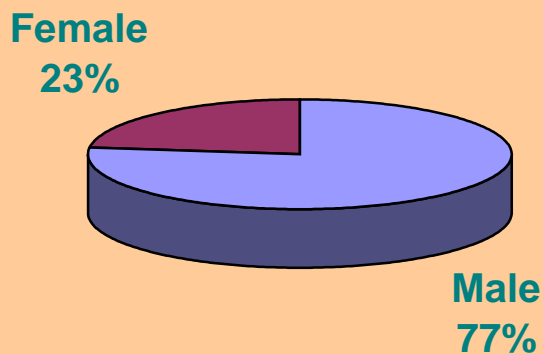
ROP Racial Disaggregation

ROP Gender Disaggregation

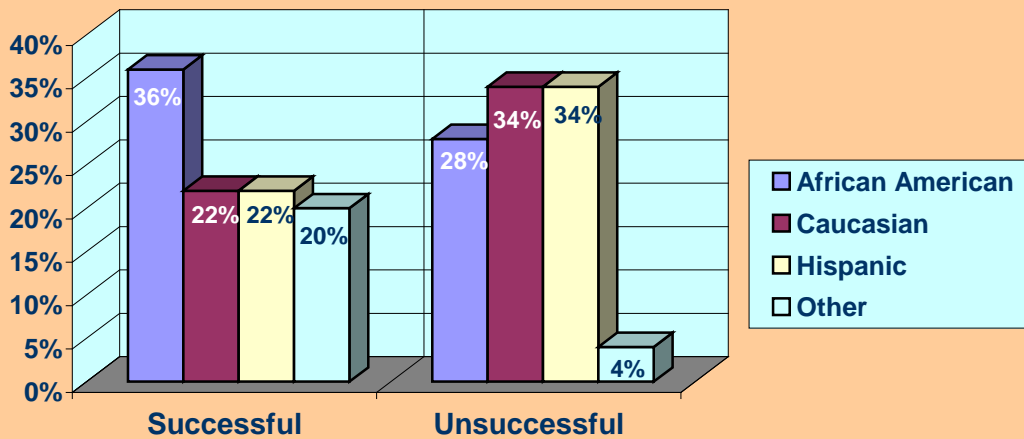

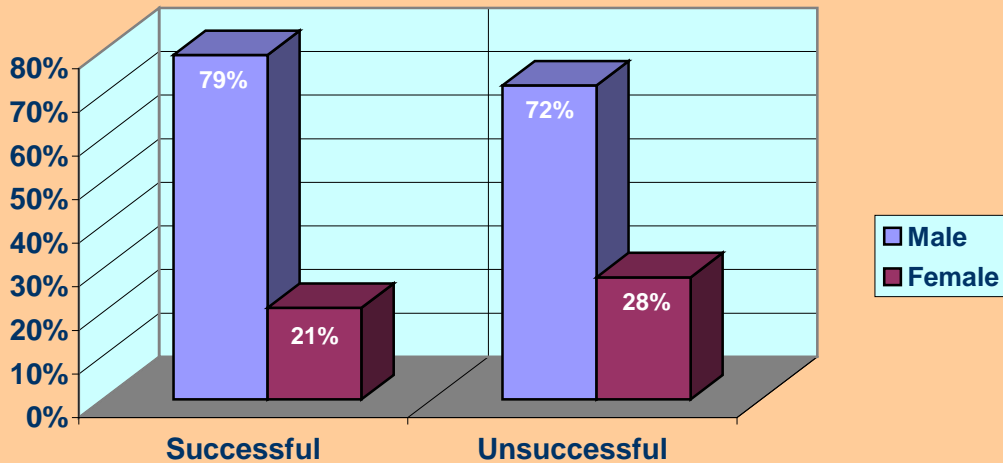

ROP Success Evaluation Racial Disaggregation



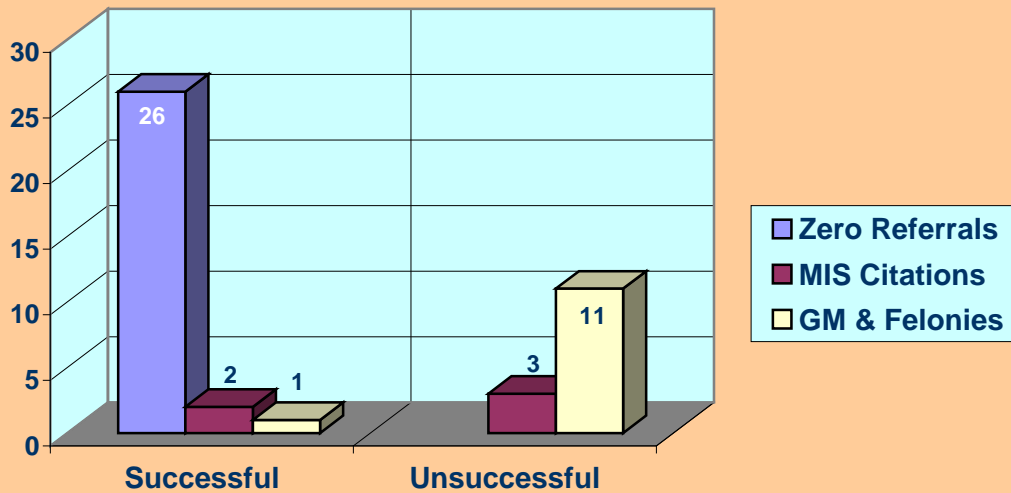
ROP Success Evaluation Gender Disaggregation
