


ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2006-01

Effective January 4, 2006, the McLean County Juvenile Detention Center is hereby prohibited from detaining all juvenile status offenders and non-offenders. A status offender is defined as a juvenile accused of an offense that would not be criminal if committed by an adult, such as truancy, curfew violations, running away from home or a placement, or ordinance violations such as consumption of alcohol or tobacco. Additionally, no individual shall be placed in secure detention who is a dependent, neglected or abused minor.

Further, the McLean County Juvenile Detention Center is prohibited from placing in secure detention any juvenile detained for criminal contempt or on a warrant when the sole underlying offense is a status offense as defined above.

In the event a juvenile is arrested on an outstanding warrant and where the underlying offense is a status offense, the arresting agency is hereby authorized to release the juvenile on a personal recognizance bond.
