General Provisions

The Disproportionate Minority Contact Partners are committed to discovering the extent to which disproportionate minority contact exists within the Ventura County juvenile justice system and to work towards eliminating any such disproportionality.

The Disproportionate Minority Contact Partners intend to work together to achieve the following:

- To gather data relating to disproportionate minority contact in Ventura County, in particular as it relates to the juvenile justice system;
- To analyze such data;
- To formulate action plans to ameliorate any disproportionate minority contact that is found to exist;
- To implement and carry through any such plans;
- To analyze the results of any such action plans; and
- To continue to gather data on disproportionate minority contact.

Each Agency agrees to designate a representative to participate as a member of the Ventura County Disproportionate Minority Contact Workgroup (DMCW).
