

Bernalillo County Juvenile Detention Center Office of Community Custody Programs



The Community Custody Program (CCP) is an alternative to detention that offers children the opportunity to remain at home or in the community while awaiting court on their current charges.

COMMUNITY SUPERVISION

- **You and your parents or guardian must report to the CCP office (located at the east end of the Juvenile Detention parking lot) no later than 10am tomorrow morning. If you have been released on a weekend day or a holiday, you must report the next business day. If you fail to report to CCP, you can be re-arrested.**
- You and your parents or guardian will also report to the Juvenile Probation and Parole Office for further review of your case. (You will meet with JPPO after reporting to CCP)
- You are on **24-hour house arrest**, unless you are with a parent or legal guardian.
- Your driving privileges are **revoked** unless the court gives you permission to drive.
- All rules will be reviewed with you tomorrow at CCP. If you have an emergency, you can call 381-2916 (pager). Leave your telephone number and a CCP officer will call you back.
- All clients are subject to random drug tests at their own expense, each drug test is \$6.25. These must be paid by money order in advance. Please have at least 2 money orders when you report to the CCP office tomorrow.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO** friends and/or associates are allowed at your residence (girlfriends, boyfriends, baby's mother or fathers')
- CLIENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE BERNALILLO COUNTY FOR ANY REASON.
