ORDER OF HOME CONFINEMENT WITH ELECTRONIC MONITORING

This Cause now coming to be heard upon the petition filed herein and the appearance of the parent and the minor respondent being now in open court in his/her own proper person and the court having jurisdiction of all parties to this cause and the subject matter, finds that:

\_\_\_\_\_ There has been a finding of probable cause and urgent and immediate necessity and that the minor respondent is subject to confinement in the Juvenile Temporary Detention Center.

\_\_\_\_\_ The minor respondent has been adjudicated a delinquent minor and is pending a dispositional hearing and is subject to confinement in the Juvenile Temporary Detention Center.

\_\_\_\_\_ The minor respondent was placed on probation and a violation of probation hearing is pending and that there has been a finding of urgent and immediate necessity subjecting the minor to confinement in the Juvenile Temporary Detention Center.

Having considered the nature and circumstances of the pending offense(s), the history of delinquency charges and the propensity of the minor to abscond, the court finds that the unconditional release of said respondent, while pending either adjudication, disposition, or under an order of probation, would not provide the necessary protection of the respondent or the person or property of another. The court may place the respondent on home confinement in the home of his/her parent(s) in lieu of secure detention. Minor respondent is determined to be eligible for electronically monitored home confinement under the supervision of the probation department:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT THE MITTIMUS OF THE MINOR RESPONDENT TO THE JUVENILE TEMPORARY DETENTION CENTER BE STAYED AND THE MINOR IS DIRECTED IMMEDIATELY TO THE HOME OF HIS/HER PARENT(S) OR GUARDIAN(S) SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. MINOR must wear an electronic monitoring transmitter, 24 hours a day, during the term of this order;
2. MINOR must appear at all subsequent court hearings;
3. MINOR must reside and remain within the home of his/her parent(s) or guardian(s);
4. MINOR'S absences from home are limited to school attendance, emergency medical attention, and religious services as approved in advance by the probation officer;
5. MINOR must attend school and return home immediately after his/her last class;
6. MINOR must make himself/herself available to a probation officer's visits and telephone calls for the purpose of verifying compliance with this order;
7. MINOR must not consume or possess any alcohol or controlled substances;
8. MINOR must not violate any criminal statute of any jurisdiction, and shall not possess a firearm or any other dangerous weapons;
9. MINOR must maintain positive electronic connection at all times with a field monitoring device placed in the home;
10. MINOR and parent(s) or guardian(s) must permit the sheriff to enter the home to inspect, protect, or retrieve electronic monitoring equipment.

The minor applies to the Court for conditional release from detention under an Order of Home Confinement with Electronic Monitoring.

- MINOR understands that he/she will wear an Electronic Monitoring transmitter on his/her ankle 24 hours a day.
- MINOR understands that he/she will not be allowed to leave his/her home without Court permission.
- MINOR agrees not to damage or tamper with the Electronic Monitoring Equipment.
- MINOR understands the he/she will receive phone calls and will allow visits from the Probation Department and the Sheriffs Department to verify that he/she is home and to inspect, secure and retrieve the Electronic Monitoring equipment placed in his/her home and upon his/her person.
- MINOR understands that he/she will not violate any laws including use of alcohol or drugs and possession or use of weapons.
- MINOR understands that violating the Order of Home Confinement with Electronic Monitoring will constitute reasonable cause for his/her immediate detention in the Juvenile Temporary Detention Center.

THE COURT HEREBY RETAINS JURISDICTION OF THIS CAUSE FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING SUCH FURTHER ORDERS, AS THE COURT SHALL DEEM TO BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE MINOR RESPONDENT AND THE PUBLIC.

THE MINOR RESPONDENT WILL IMMEDIATELY BE DETAINED WITHIN THE COOK COUNTY JUVENILE TEMPORARY DETENTION CENTER BY ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER PRESENTING A VERIFIED AFFIDAVIT DECLARING A BONA FIDE BREACH OF THE ELECTRONIC MONITORING SYSTEM INSTALLED UPON THE PERSON OF THE MINOR RESPONDENT.

THE HOME CONFINEMENT OFFICERS SHALL IMMEDIATELY RETURN THE MINOR TO THE JUVENILE TEMPORARY DETENTION CENTER FOR SECURE DETENTION IN THE EVENT THAT THE ELECTRONIC MONITORING EQUIPMENT CANNOT BE PROPERLY INSTALLED IN THE MINOR'S HOME. THIS ORDER SHALL CONSTITUTE THE BASIS FOR AUTHORIZING THE MINOR'S DETENTION PENDING REVIEW BY THE COURT.
